



The Remembrance Project's Key Principles to Save Lives

The Remembrance Project serves as a voice for the countless of American victims who were killed by illegal aliens. Our mission is rooted in love for country, compassion for victims, and a firm belief in justice. We support common sense policies that protect American lives, protect American culture, uphold the Rule of Law, and bring justice to Americans after decades of an illegal alien invasion.

- 1. No Amnesty and no Exceptions.** Do not reward those who break our laws. Exceptions is amnesty. Therefore, amnesty and exceptions only invite more lawlessness.
- 2. End Birthright Citizenship.** The 14th Amendment was never intended to grant citizenship to illegal alien children born in the U.S. This misinterpretation must end and correct previously issued documentation.
- 3. Complete the Southern Border Wall.** A border wall is a key component in upholding our nation's safety, sovereignty, and honoring the laws that define America.
- 4. Protect the Census.** The Census should reflect only our citizen population. Counting illegal aliens distorts representation thus shifts political power by those who know nothing about USA! The Census must include a citizenship question.
- 5. Mass Deportations.** Enforce deportations with compassion and purpose. The law must be enforced. We support the return of all illegal aliens to their home countries where they can reunite with families and help build stronger communities abroad. No amnesty and no exceptions.
- 6. E-verify all workers.** Close the loophole on e-verify. All workers must be "*legally authorized to work in the United States.*" Corrupt employers hire illegal aliens under the category of contract workers/sub-contractors. Most egregious are home builders. Lawless employers must face the full force of the law, pay heavy fines, and prosecute for aiding & abetting illegals. It's the law!
- 7. Stop IRS Support to Illegal Aliens.** The IRS issues ITINs (Individual Tax Identification Numbers) to illegal aliens, allowing them to open businesses that hire undocumented workers at lower wages—undercutting American-owned businesses and violating federal law. Therefore, every business owner must be legally authorized to work in the U.S. All ITIN holders must be legally authorized to work in the U.S.

- 8. End In-State Tuition for illegal aliens.** Out-of-state American students pay a higher tuition, while illegal aliens receive discounted rates. This practice must end and must be codified.
- 9. Codify English as the Official Language.** We support codifying English as the official language of the United States.
- 10. Defund NGOs That Facilitate Illegal Immigration.** No funds or business licenses to non-governmental organizations that aid and abet illegal aliens. This “funneling” of taxpayer money to aid and abet illegal aliens is a criminal act that must be prosecuted. Politicians must stop funding America’s demise.
- 11. Officially Proclaim October as the “Remembrance Month.”** Sign a proclamation titled: “Remembrance Month for Americans Killed by Illegal Aliens” for the month of October. The Remembrance Project extended President Donald Trump’s proclamation for National Day of Remembrance for Americans Killed Illegal Aliens the president signed for our organization on October 30, 2020, to a month-long remembrance.
- 12. End or Pause Legal Immigration.** End or pause legal immigration until all illegal aliens have been removed in order to preserve the U.S. Constitution and our American culture, to reinstate the Rule of Law, and reclaim justice for American families.
- 13. End Sanctuary Policies.** Sanctuary jurisdictions are illegal and unconstitutional. No taxpayer funds to sanctuary jurisdictions.
- 14. Social Benefits for American Citizens.** These benefits should be reserved for citizens—not extended to those here unlawfully.
- 15. No Reciprocity for Licenses from States Issuing Licenses to Illegal Aliens** (includes but not limited to Driver Licenses and Trade Licenses). States should not honor licenses from states that undermine our immigration system by issuing licenses to illegals. Trucking companies from states that use unlicensed drivers are a danger and must be barred from transporting interstate.
